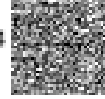

AMARJOT BHATTI, J.

1. Ramzan Mohammad has filed this petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing respondents No.2 and 3 to undertake immediate and necessary measures to ensure protection of petitioner's life and liberty from the actions of private respondents or any other direction which the court may deem fit.

2. It is pointed out that on the statement of present petitioner FIR No.49 dated 18.07.2024 was registered at Police Station Sandaur, District Malerkotla (Annexure P-1). Since then the private respondents No.4 to 7 were extending threats. He gave representation to Senior Superintendent of Police, Malerkotla (Annexure P-2) but no action is taken.

3. Notice of motion.

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4. On asking of this Court, Mr. Kewal Singh, Addl. A.G., Punjab accepts notice on behalf of State. On instructions from ASI Manjit Singh, Belt No.1439 SGR, he submits that respondents No.4 to 7 have been arrested in the aforesaid FIR on 30.07.2024.

5. Considering the aforesaid facts, it is clear that respondents No.2 and 3 have taken prompt action regarding the FIR registered on the statement of petitioner. In case petitioner apprehends any threat to his life and liberty, respondents No.2 and 3 are directed to take adequate measures considering the threat perception.

6. Petition is accordingly disposed of.

7. Pending miscellaneous application(s), if any, stand disposed of accordingly.
