Instant petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of a writ, order or direction particularly in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to pay the interest on the delayed payment, which was released to the petitioners on 05.02.2019, i.e. after about 3 years and 10 months of issuing the Certificate dated 16.04.2015, Annexure P-1.
