The instant writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India *inter alia* seeking a writ in the nature of Mandamus for directing respondents No.2 and 3 to install the Moga Burji 14400/Sajja Ghanaur at Sub Miner. Ghanaur.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners, at the outset, submits that he may be permitted to withdraw the instant writ petition with liberty to the petitioners to submit a detailed representation before respondent No.3, for redressal of their grievances, as raised in the instant writ petition. Further, it is prayed that the concerned authority may be directed to decide the said representation in a time bound manner.

3. At this stage, Mr. Navneet Singh, Senior Deputy Advocate

General, Punjab appears on behalf of the respondents-State, in pursuance of the advance copy of paper book having already been supplied to him, and submits that in case any such representation is filed by the petitioners before respondent No.3, then the same shall be considered and decided within a period of four weeks.

4. Keeping in view the aforesaid submissions made by learned counsel for the parties, the present writ petition is dismissed as withdrawn with liberty to the petitioners to submit a detailed representation before the Executive Engineer/Devigarh Patiala, Canal and Ground Water Division, Water Resources Department, Punjab (respondent No.3 herein), for redressal of their grievances, within a period of two weeks from today; which shall be decided by respondent No.3 by way of passing a speaking order within a period of next four weeks, after affording due opportunity of hearing to the concerned parties.

5. It is made clear that in case, petitioners fail to file the said representation within the stipulated period of two weeks from today then this order shall have no effect.

6. All pending application(s), if any, shall also stand closed.
