Mr. Vikrant Singh, Advocate has put in appearance and filed power of attorney on behalf of respondent No.8, which is taken on record.

Status report by way of an affidavit dated 30.08.2024 of Sh. Sanjay Kumar, HPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Ratia District Fatehabad, on behalf of respondents No.1 to 6, has been filed, which is taken on record.

In Para No.3 to 6 of the aforesaid affidavit it has been recorded as under:-

“3. That during investigation, investigating officer inspected the place of occurrence and recorded the statement of witnesses under section 180 of BNSS and Inquest proceedings were conducted and post mortem of the dead body of deceased Amritpal Singh was conducted

by board of doctors. True copy of post mortem report of Amritpal Singh is annexed as Annexure R-1 for the kind perusal of this Hon'ble Court. As per post mortem, Cause of death is given below: -

"The probable cause of death in this case, in our opinion is Hamorrhage and shock which is also the injury to vitals organs lungs intestine. It is caused by blunt force trauma/impact. All injuries are antemortem nature and sufficient to cause death in ordinary course of life. However, final opinion will be given after receiving reports of chemical analysis".

4. That during investigation, petitioner moved a representation dated 10.07.2024 (Annexure P-3) to the respondent No. 4 with the request to register the FIR under section 103(1) of BNS 2023 against the accused persons and same was marked to the deponent for conducting inquiry of the said representation.

5. That during further course investigation, on 19.07.2024. 05.08.2024 and 08.08.2024 respectively, Investigating Officer obtained call details record of mobile numbers 8683937228, 7404328828, 9253005045, 8168415959, 7509430385. 9053028828, 7497086187, 7988263866 for the period from 01.07.2024 to 05.07.2024.

6. That on receiving of the representation dated 10.07.2024 (Annexure P-3), on 17.07.2024, a notice was issued by the deponent to the petitioner and respondent no. 8 Jashanpreet Singh alias Jashan, Lakhbir Singh and Harman Singh to appear in the office of the deponent on 20.07.2024 at 11:00 AM for preliminary enquiry of the representation submitted by the petitioner and same was duly served through SHO, Police Station City Ratia but till date, inquiry upon the representation dated 10.07.2024 is still pending and is being conducting by the deponent in accordance with law and without any influence of the

private respondents. Deponent also perused the Call details record of the mobile numbers mentioned in above paras, but till date no new fact came on the file and thorough investigation is being conducted so far.”

A perusal of the aforesaid assertions crystallized the pending of the investigation, the same is likely to concluded.

Learned State counsel ensures the Court that investigation will take another two months time and thereafter final report shall be submitted to the competent Court of jurisdiction within one month thereafter.

The instant petition has been disposed of with the aforesaid observations that the investigation is moving in the right direction.
