JASGURPREET SINGH PURI J.(Oral)

1. After arguing for some time learned Senior counsel for the petitioner and learned counsel for respondents are *ad idem* that the present petition can be disposed of in view of instructions obtained by both the counsels.

2. Learned counsel for the respondents stated that he has instructions to state that in case the order of unfair means against the petitioner is in place and is kept intact then the respondents will not ask the petitioner to repeat the 7th and 8th Semesters except for those minor examinations in which he had not appeared and the petitioner will have to only appear for 5th and 6th Semesters.

3. Learned senior counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner stated that he has instructions to state that he will not press the challenge to



the order imposing punishment for unfair means against the petitioner and in view of the statement made by learned counsel for the respondents that petitioner will not be compelled to repeat 7th and 8th Semesters examinations except for minor examinations in which he had not appeared and he will appear for 5th and 6th Semesters examination and attend classes as well and therefore the present petition may kindly be disposed of.

4. In view of the aforesaid factual position as so stated by both the learned counsels for the parties, the present petition is disposed of in the aforesaid terms.
