1. Learned State counsel has submitted that as per Section 3(2) of Haryana Good Conduct Prisoners (Temporary Release) Act, 2022, period for which a convicted prisoner may be released is 10 weeks in calander year cumulatively since the said period pertaining to the year 2023 expired on 31.12.2023, therefore, the period of his previous temporary parole as availed during the period from 01.01.2024 till 19.01.2024 is to be counted as a period of parole for this calendar year i.e. the year 2024 and not the year 2023.

2. In view of situation so explained above, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks withdrawal of the present petition with the prayer that the representation dated 03.08.2024 (Annexure P-1) as filed by the petitioner before respondent no.3 for grant of parole which is still pending may be treated as an application for grant of emergency parole and be disposed of expeditiously.

2. Accordingly, the petition is disposed of with a direction to the Superintendent of Jail, Central Jail No.1, Hisar to treat representation dated 03.08.2024 (Annexure P-1) as an application of the petitioner for grant of emergency parole and to consider and decide it within a period of 15 days from the receipt of certified copy of this order.

3. Copy of this order be sent to concerned Court.

4. Pending applications, if any, also stand disposed of.
