1. Feeling aggrieved against the alleged inaction on the part of respondent authorities, petitioners have approached this Court by way of instant petition, seeking issuance of appropriate directions to the respondents to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner as they apprehends eminent danger at the hands of private respondent No. 4 and his accomplices.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has been running from pillar to post but their grievance was not being redressed by the respondent authorities. Having been left with no other option, petitioner has approached the Senior Superintendent of Police, Sector 9, Chandigarh, respondent No. 2, by way of representation dated 18.05.2024 (Annexure P-7), but the same is also pending decision. He also submits that the petitioners will be

satisfied in case respondent No.2, the Senior Superintendent of Police, Sector 9, Chandigarh is directed to look into the matter and take appropriate steps, in accordance with law.

3. Having heard the learned counsel for the petitioners and after going through the case file, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Sector 9, Chandigarh, respondent No. 2 to consider the representation dated 18.05.2024 (Annexure P-7) and decide the same by passing an appropriate order thereon, strictly as per law, within a period of two weeks from today.
