Through the instant petition, filed under Section 528 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 (BNSS), a prayer is made for issuance of mandamus upon the learned trial Court concerned, who is seized of the criminal complaint bearing No.COMI-80-2024 dated 21.05.2024, under Section 156(3) Cr.P.C., titled as 'Ravinder Kumar Vs. Sanjeev Kumar and others' (Annexure P-15), to expedite its disposal in a time bound manner.
2. The instant complaint was filed on dated 21.05.2024. The learned trial Court concerned, has already sought report from the State, regarding the complaint preferred by the present petitioner.
