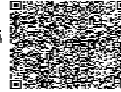

By way of the present Criminal Writ Petition, the petitioner seeks issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to release him on emergency parole for a period of four weeks, as his mother is suffering from serious heart problem.

2. Vide order dated 08.08.2024, notice of motion was issued in this case.

3. The petitioner is a convict and is undergoing rigorous imprisonment for 20 years in FIR No.12 dated 03.02.2021, under Sections 363, 366A, 368, 201 IPC and Section 6 of POCSO Act, registered at Police Station,

Jatusana, Rewari, District Rewari. Presently, the petitioner is confined in District Jail, Gurugram.

4. It is the case of the petitioner that his mother namely, Kamlesh wife of Rajender, is suffering from serious heart problem. She was got admitted in Civil Hospital, Rewari on 28.07.2024 and as per medical report, there is blockage in her heart. In view of the said emergency, the petitioner seeks his release on parole for a period of four weeks, so that he can meet and look after his ailing mother. The petitioner has enclosed medical history of his mother along with the present writ petition (Annexure P-1).

5. Today, on resumed hearing, an affidavit dated 13.08.2024 of Deputy Superintendent, District Jail, Gurugram, has been tendered in course of hearing by learned State counsel, which is taken on record. A copy thereof has been supplied to counsel opposite. In para no.2 of the said affidavit, it has been stated that mother of the petitioner is suffering from heart disease.

6. In view of the above, we dispose of the present petition and grant four weeks' parole to the petitioner commencing from the date of release, subject to his furnishing fresh bonds to the satisfaction of the competent authority/Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate concerned. The period of four weeks shall be counted from the date of his release. The releasing Court/Duty Magistrate

shall also notify the dates of release and surrender of the petitioner. The petitioner shall surrender before the jail authorities on the date and time to be notified by the releasing Court/Duty Magistrate. After surrender, the petitioner shall furnish a surrender certificate.

7. All the pending application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed of.
