HARKESH MANUJA J. (Oral)

1. By way of present petition filed under Section 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, prayer has been made for issuance of contempt proceedings against the respondents on account of alleged non-compliance of order dated 03.05.2024 passed by this Court in CWP-10067-2024.

2. Learned State counsel, on instructions, informs that in terms of compliance report dated 23.08.2024, a speaking order dated 16.08.2024 has already been passed and a new time table has been prepared, which shall be implemented in all probability within a period of two weeks from today.

3. In view of the aforesaid stand taken by the learned State counsel representing the respondents, learned counsel for the petitioner does not press the present petition.

However, the petitioner would be at liberty to seek revival, in case the needful is not done within the aforementioned stipulated period. It is made clear that in an eventuality wherein, the petitioner seeks revival on account of inaction of the respondents, the concerned officer would be liable to pay a sum of Rs.1 lakh as costs from his/her own pocket in favour of the petitioner.

4. Disposed of accordingly. Rule stands discharged.
