1. Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for issuance of appropriate direction to respondents No. 2 and 3 to submit the status report with regard to complaint dated 27.07.2023 (Annexure P-2) filed by the petitioner and further prayer is made for issuance of a direction to respondents No. 2 and 3 to decide representation dated 03.06.2023 (Annexure P-1) made by the petitioner in a time bound manner.
2. Learned State counsel refers to status report dated 21.09.2023 and submits that son of the petitioner alongwith his co-accused were found in conscious possession of contraband falling within the ambit of commercial quantity and one country made pistol with live four cartridges were also recovered from the accused and son of the petitioner. The son of the petitioner

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alongwith his co-accused were arrested in FIR No. 93 dated 09.06.2022 under Sections 21 and 22 of the NDPS Act read with Sections 25 and 27 of Arms Act, 1959 registered at police Station Majitha, Amritsar (Rural).

3. In view of the above, this Court finds no ground for issuance of any further direction as prayed for by the petitioner.

4. The petition is disposed of accordingly.
