1. The appellant had filed the present appeal against the impugned judgment dated 28.02.2020, passed by the Special Court, Jalandhar, whereby the appellant was convicted under Section 22 (b) of NDPS Act and was sentenced to undergo RI for a period of 03 years and to pay a fine of Rs.30,000/-.
