In the present writ petition, the grievance being raised by the petitioner is that the benefit of adhoc service rendered by the petitioner w.e.f. 24.07.1998 till 31.01.2003 has not been given to the petitioner to be treated as a qualifying service, which benefit is liable to be given keeping in view the judgment of this Court in ***CWP No.3780 of 2019 titled as Sharda Rani vs. Guru Nanak Dev University, Amritsar, decided on 11.05.2022.***

2. Learned counsel for the respondents has not been able to differentiate the applicability of the judgment in ***Sharda Rani's case (supra)***, upon the petitioner so as to grant him the benefit of adhoc service for computing the pensionary benefits.

3. As the learned counsel for the respondents has not been able to dispute the entitlement of the petitioner for the grant of the benefit of adhoc service for computing the pensionary benefits and the same relief has already been granted to an employee namely Sharda Rani by this Court, the present petition is also disposed of in terms of the order passed in ***Sharda Rani's case (supra)***.
