1. The instant petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of FIR No.2315 dated 03.10.2023 (Annexure P-6) under Section 174-A of the IPC registered at Police Station Shivaji Nagar, District Gurugram along with all consequential proceedings arising therefrom.

2. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner submits that subsequent to registration of the FIR in question, with the intervention of well-wishers and respectables, the parties had ironed out their differences and arrived at an amicable settlement, as a result of which the complainant had withdrawn the Complaint filed by him against the petitioner. In support, learned counsel has drawn the attention of this Court to Annexure P-7, which is an order dated 11.05.2024 passed by learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class-cum-Presiding Officer, National Lok Adalat, Gurugram. Learned counsel



submits that in the circumstances, continuation of the FIR (Annexure P-6) and consequential proceedings arising therefrom would not serve any useful purpose, and thus, the FIR in question be quashed.

3. Notice of motion.

4. Ms. Trishanjali Sharma, Dy. Advocate General, Haryana, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the State.

5. I have heard learned counsel for the parties and perused the relevant material on record.

6. In the light of submissions made by learned counsel representing the petitioner coupled with the fact that since the original Complaint, on the basis of which the FIR in question had been lodged, already stands withdrawn by the complainant, this Court deems it appropriate to quash the criminal proceedings in the instant case. Accordingly, the petition is allowed, and the FIR (Annexure P-6) and all consequential proceedings arising out of it, are quashed.
