The instant application has been filed under Section 151 of the Code of Civil Procedure, 1908 for seeking withdrawal of the present writ petition.

The above said application is supported by an affidavit of the petitioner himself. It has been averred in the application that the dispute in question has already been settled between the petitioner and Prabhjit Singh Sidhu vide compromise dated 03.11.2023 (Annexure A-1).

In view of the facts stated therein, the application is

allowed and hearing in the main case is pre-poned and the writ petition is taken up on Board today itself.

The present petition has been filed for seeking issuance of directions to the respondent No.2 to investigate the kidnapping of petitioner, his son and nephew and continuous oppression and harassment by respondent No.8-Prabhjit Singh Sidhu.

Since the application i.e CM-1023-CWP-2024 has been moved by the applicant-petitioner for seeking withdrawal of the present writ petition as the dispute has already been settled between the petitioner and Prabhjit Singh Sidhu vide compromise dated 03.11.2023.

Learned State Counsel also has no objection to the aforesaid prayer if allowed.

The present writ petition is disposed of as withdrawn.
