ARUN PALLI, J. (Oral):

Vide this application, the applicants/petitioners (State of Haryana and another) pray for withdrawal of the main petition (CWP-31106-2018).

Learned Additional Advocate General, Haryana, with reference to the averments set out in the application, submits that informant/complainant had withdrawn the case No.40 of 2017. And, accordingly the proceedings before the Competition Commission of India (CCI) were closed. Further, the issues, raised by the applicants/petitioners before the CCI, having already been adjudicated by this Court in **CWP No.9558 of 2015 (M/s VPN Buildcon Pvt. Ltd. Vs. State of Haryana and others)**, they be permitted to withdraw the petition, at this stage. And, the issues that are sought to be raised in the petition at hand be kept open.

Accordingly, learned counsel for respondent No.1 submits that applicants/petitioners be permitted to withdraw the petition with liberty to revive the same by moving an appropriate application, in the event, any further proceedings are undertaken by CCI/CREDAI-NCR, in similar matters.
