Prayer in the present writ petition is for seeking directions to the trial Court to expeditiously decide the pending *Civil Suit No. 1976 of 2018* titled as “*Gurjit Singh versus Pritam Kaur and others*” in a time bound manner.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner contends that last opportunity to conclude evidence had been granted to the plaintiff on 19.07.2024 and that the said Civil Suit is pending for more than 06 years but no steps have been taken for expeditious adjudication of the said Civil Suit. He contends that he would be satisfied at the juncture in case a direction is issued to the Civil Court to decide the said Civil Suit in an expeditious manner.
