Instant application has been filed for placing on record Annexures P-3 and P-4 and further exempting the petition from filing the certified/typed copies of the same.

Present writ petition has been filed for directing respondent No.2 to decide the representation dated 05.09.2022 (Annexure P-1)

within a time bound period as the same involved significant question with regard to the ancestral agricultural land of the petitioner and respondent No.2 is not deciding the same without any tangible reason.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted before this Court that for the redressal of grievance of the petitioner, he has already filed his representation dated 05.09.2022 (Annexure P-1) before respondent No.2 but no decision has been taken on the same till date. He further submits that the petitioner will be satisfied if a direction is issued to respondent No.2 i.e. Deputy Commissioner, Amritsar to decide the same in a time bound manner.

Notice of motion to the official respondents at this stage.

On asking of the Court, Mr. Navneet Singh, Sr. DAG, Punjab appears and accepts notice on behalf of the respondents-State. He has submitted that the representation filed by the petitioner before respondent No.2 would be decided expeditiously.

In view of the above position, the present petition stands disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2-the Deputy Commissioner, Amritsar to look into the representation of the petitioner dated 05.09.2022 (Annexure P-1) and decide the same in accordance with law within a period of four weeks from today.
