1. Present Civil Writ Petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India praying for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari quashing the impugned un-dated charge sheet (Annexure P-6) to the extent departmental proceedings has been initiated against the petitioner due to his involvement in FIR No. 1944 dated 22.11.2022 registered under Sections 120-B, 217, 218, 384, 419, 420, 466, 467, 468 and 471 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 and Sections 7 and 13 of the Prevention of corruption Act, 1988 at Police Station Shivaji Nagar, District Gurugram.
