The petition has been filed, *inter alia*, seeking a writ of *mandamus* directing the respondents to step up the pay of the petitioner as equal to his junior as per Rule 7(iv) and 12 of Haryana Civil Services (Assured Career Progression) Rules, 2008.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that at this stage, the petitioner will be satisfied in case he is permitted to make a fresh representation before the second respondent, raising the grievance as has been raised in this petition, and the same may be ordered to be decided within a specified period.

3. Notice of motion.

4. Mr. R.S. Budhwar, Addl. AG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of respondents/State and submits that in case such representation is filed by the petitioner, the same will be decided by the second respondent, expeditiously.

5. In view thereof, without going into the merits of the case, the petition is disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to file representation before the second respondent-Director, Secondary Education, within two weeks from today. In case any such representation is filed by the petitioner, the same will be decided by the officer concerned by passing a speaking order thereupon, within three months of receiving the representation.
