1. At the outset, Mr. B.S. Seemar, learned counsel for respondent No.1-Board submitted that the impugned rejection order dated 02.02.2024 (Annexure P-7) is undoubtedly an unreasoned order and submitted that the respondent-Board wishes to take corrective measures by passing a detailed speaking order in accordance with law and after affording an opportunity of hearing to the petitioner within a period of two weeks from today.
