Prayer in the present petition is for directing respondent No.2 – The Director, Technical Education & Industrial Training, Punjab to conduct an inquiry on the complaint dated 25.04.2022 submitted by the petitioner against respondents No.4 and 5 for alleged embezzlement of funds by misusing their powers.

The counsel for the petitioner was granted time to collect and produce some material on record, on the basis of which the allegations levelled by him could be corroborated or be *prima facie* substantiated.

Having availed certain opportunities to place on record the necessary documents, counsel for the petitioner informs that he could not get any other document/material in support of his claim/prayer. He thus seeks withdrawal of the present petition so as to take recourse to the alternative remedy(ies) available to him in accordance with law.
