1. The present Civil Revision Petition has been filed under Article 227 of the Constitution of India for setting aside the order dated 06.07.2019 passed by the Civil Judge (Jr. Divn.), Malerkotla whereby the application of the respondents for direction to the petitioner to pay court fees has been allowed.

2. It has been brought to the notice of this Court that vide order dated 30.07.2022 passed by the trial Court, the main suit has been dismissed for non-prosecution as the plaintiff has already died and no legal representative has come forward to pursue the case and thus, the present petition has been rendered infructuous.

3. In view of the above, present Civil Revision Petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.
