1. The petitioner is seeking quashing of order dated 11.06.2024 (Annexure P-1) passed by learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Chandigarh, whereby his bail bonds were cancelled and non-bailable warrants were issued against the petitioner in case No.COMA-7151-2022 titled as 'ESIC Vs. Pan Polar Engineers'.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner at the outset submits that the petitioner is willing and ready to appear, and surrender before the Trial Court. Hence, in the aforementioned facts and circumstances, the petitioner be protected till his appearance before the Trial Court, and directions be given to the Trial Court that his bail application, which he would be filing on his surrender, be decided expeditiously.

3. Notice of motion.

4. On asking of the Court, Mr. Rajiv Vij, Addl. P.P., U.T., Chandigarh, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-U.T., Chandigarh.

5. In view of the limited prayer made by the learned counsel

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for the petitioner, the instant petition is disposed of with directions to the petitioner to appear and surrender before the Trial Court within 07 days from today. Till then, no coercive steps be taken against the petitioner. However, this shall be subject to payment of costs of Rs.10,000/- to be deposited with Poor Patients Welfare Fund, PGIMER, Chandigarh, which shall be a condition precedent.

6. It is made clear that in case, the petitioner fails to surrender before the Trial Court within 07 days from today and to comply with the above said directions, this order shall be of no avail to him, thereafter. The petitioner shall also produce the receipt of the costs deposited by him, before the learned Trial Court. In case, on appearance and surrender, the petitioner moves an application for bail, the Trial Court shall make earnest efforts to decide it expeditiously, in accordance with law.
