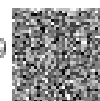

In the present petition, grievance of the petitioner is that though he is working as Sweeper with the respondent-department since 1993 but his services are not being regularized despite the fact that there are various instructions, which have been issued by the respondent-Government of Punjab for regularizing the services of Class-IV employees.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has already raised the said grievance in the legal notice dated 29.10.2023 (Annexure P-15) but the same is still pending consideration with the respondents and the petitioner will be satisfied, at this stage, in case direction is issued to the respondents to decide the same by passing an appropriate speaking order in a time bound manner.



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Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Arun Gupta, DAG, Punjab who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State and submits that in case, the legal notice dated 29.10.2023 (Annexure P-15) has been received in the office of the concerned authorities and the same is still pending consideration with the authorities concerned, the same will be decided by the competent authority within a period of eight weeks from the date of the receipt of certified copy of this order by passing an appropriate speaking order. Learned State counsel further submits that in case, it is found feasible to accept the claim of the petitioner, the same will be accepted, otherwise due reasons will be mentioned for not accepting the claim of the petitioner in the speaking order to be passed and the said order will be conveyed to him.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement of the learned State counsel, the present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.
