1. The present petition has been filed by the petitioner under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case having FIR No.254 dated 19.04.2022, under Sections 406, 420 of IPC, registered at Police Station Old Industrial Panipat.
2. The allegations in nutshell are that the accused persons including the present petitioner took amount of Rs.2 lac from complainant by alluring him to do so on the pretext that they will double the said amount with the help of magical powers possessed by them.
3. Counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the earlier order, the petitioner has joined the investigation with the police.
4. The State counsel on instructions from SI Bijender Singh apprised the Court that indeed the petitioner has joined investigation with

the police and is not required for any further investigation in the present case.

5. In view of the above, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and order of interim bail dated 18.01.2024 is made absolute. The petitioner should abide by the conditions as are provided under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
