- 1. This is a civil writ petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for setting aside the order dated 31.03.2021 (Annexure P-3) passed by the Appellate Tribunal-cum-District Magistrate, Sangrur, whereby the appeal filed by respondent no.4 against the order dated 09.11.2020 passed by the Sub Divisional Magistrate, Sangrur, has been allowed.
