This is an application under Section 482 Cr.P.C., seeking interim bail for a period of two months for getting better treatment of the petitioner namely Gurpreet Singh @ Gopi.

In compliance of the order dated 27.11.2024, medical status report filed by way of an affidavit of Shyamal Jyoti, Superintendent Central Jail, Kapurthala is taken on record. The main contents of medical report reads as under:-

As per record, Gurpreet Singh son of Mohinder Pal (PID- 814747) is lodged in Central Jail Kapurthala. He is known case of HIV+ve, HCV+ve, PLHA with multiple Parietal Abscess.

On 24/10/2024 he was referred to Civil Hospital Kapurthala with complaint of weakness of left side for specialist examination. The patient was advised for MRI at Guru Nanak Dev Hospital Amritsar.

On 25/10/2024 he was referred to Guru Nanak Dev Hospital Amritsar where he was examined in neurology department and he was advised MRI Brain, which was not done on same day.

On 05/11/2024 he was referred to Guru Nanak Dev Hospital Amritsar where he was admitted and managed conservatively. Patient was further referred to PIMER Chandigarh, patient was investigated and he was diagnosed with PLHA with multiple parietal abscess. He was prescribed oral medications and discharged on 19/11/2024. On 22/11/2024 patient was referred to GNDH Amritsar with diagnosed of PLHA and multiple parietal abscess. He was advised to continue treatment as advised by surgeon of PIMER Chandigarh.

On 27/11/2024 he was referred to Civil Hospital Kapurthala with complaint of weakness of one side of body, loss of appetite, generalized weakness where he was advised to continue treatment from PGI Chandigarh.

On 07/12/2024 he was referred to Guru Nanak Dev Hospital Amritsar for advised CECT Head and which was done on the same day. At present his general condition is stable, vitals are within normal limits and he is taking oral medications as prescribed by PGI Chandigarh. The patient will be referred to PIMER Chandigarh this week for follow up."

From the above, it is evident that at the age of 31 years, the petitioner is admittedly undergoing weakness of one side of body, loss of appetite, generalized weakness etc., and have been advised treatment from PGIMER Chandigarh.

In the light of above on the humanitarian grounds, the present application is allowed.

The applicant/petitioner is directed to be released on interim bail for a period of two months subject to his furnishing bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate concerned.

The applicant/petitioner shall surrender to the Jail Authorities on 13.02.2025 at 5.00 PM.

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Learned counsel for the petitioner at this stage, do not press the present petition, which is preferred for regular bail and prays for withdrawal of the same.

Prayer is accepted.

Main petition is dismissed as withdrawn.
