In compliance of the order dated 09.01.2024, passed by this Forum, Ms. Meena Samra, Regional Manager, United India Ins. Co. Ltd. is present before this Forum.

Vide order dated 19.12.2023 on the basis of the statement made by learned counsel for the appellant a proposal was made for enhancing compensation by Rs.4,50,000/- over and above the amount already granted by the MACT concerned. Today, learned counsel for the Insurance Company has stated that the Insurance Company has agreed to enhance the compensation only by Rs.3,70,000/- and not by Rs.4,50,000/- and has signed to that effect. Learned counsel for the appellant has agreed to this counter offer of the respondent-Insurance Company.

We dispose of this case, subject to all just exceptions, with a direction to the Insurance Company to deposit a crossed-cheque in the sum of Rs.3,70,000/- (Rupees Three Lakh Seventy Thousand only) in the name of the appellant-Jai Singh with the office of the Lok Adalat of the High Court on or before 05.03.2024 failing which the amount will carry 9% interest p.a. From the date of this order till the cheque is deposited with the office of the Lok Adalat. The appellant's counsel/appellant may collect the cheque from the office of the Lok Adalat.

Copy of the order/statement be supplied /sent to the counsel/parties and file be returned to the High Court.
