LISA GILL, J.

1. Prayer is for review of order dated 07.12.2023 on the ground that total marks obtained by applicant are more than the marks obtained by last selected candidate.
2. Having heard learned counsel for applicant, we find this application to be misconceived inasmuch as it is a matter of record that applicant was unable to secure the cut off marks of 180.50 in the written examination having secured only 177.50.
3. Learned counsel is unable to point out any error apparent on record or any other ground which calls for review of the order dated 07.12.2023.
4. Review application is, accordingly, dismissed. As the matter has been considered and decided on merits, adjudication upon application seeking condonation of delay of 215 days in filing the appeal, is rendered academic. Application is disposed of accordingly.
