The petitioner, by way of present petition, seeks initiation of
contempt proceedings against the respondent(s), alleging willful
disobedience of the order dated 27.07.2023 (**Annexure P-1**) passed by this
Court in CWP No. 14028 of 2023, the operative portion thereof is extracted
hereunder:-

“Learned counsel for the respondents on
instructions from Deepak Kumar, Superintendent and
Ravinder Yadav, Assistant submits that the enquiry
proceedings will be concluded within a period of eight weeks
from today and thereafter, appropriate order will be passed
qua the benefit for which the petitioner is found entitled for
including his prayer for re-appointment and the
consequential benefits for which petitioner is found entitled
for as per the speaking order passed, be released to the

petitioner within a further period of eight weeks.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement of learned State counsel, the present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further, at this stage.

Ordered accordingly. ”

[2] In response, learned counsel for the respondent informs that upon conclusion of enquiry proceedings in favour of the petitioner, he also stands re-employed and the financial benefits shall be released to him within a period of one week from today. Learned counsel has also produced a copy of order dated 23.08.2024 passed by the office of Director General Health Services, Haryana, considering the claim of petitioner in the aforesaid writ petition bearing CWP No. 14028 of 2023, the same is taken on record.

[3] Learned counsel for the petitioner concedes the aforesaid factual position.

[4] In view of the above, no further orders are required to be passed in the present petition, as such, the same is **disposed off**.

[5] Rule stands discharged.
