The petitioner, by way of present contempt petition, seeks initiation of contempt proceedings against the respondent, alleging willful disobedience of the order dated 06.02.2024 (**Annexure P-1**) passed by this Court in CWP No. 13804 of 2021.

[2] At the time of hearing, learned counsel for the respondent(s)-UHBVNL, in compliance of the order dated 06.02.2024, has handed over a cheque dated 08.08.2024 releasing the pensionary benefits of petitioner, to the learned counsel for the petitioner, which has been accepted. A photocopy of the said cheque is retained for the purpose of record.

[3] In view of the above, learned counsel for the petitioner does not press the present petition.

[4] **Disposed off as not pressed.**

[5] However, in case any claim survives, the petitioner would be at liberty to move appropriate application before the authority concerned, which shall be considered and decided, as per law, within a period of eight weeks thereafter.
