JAGMOHAN BANSAL, J. (Oral)

1. The petitioner through instant petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is seeking direction to the respondents to regularize her as she is working for last more than 20 years.
2. Mr. Kapil Kakkar, Advocate submits that similarly situated employees filed *CWP No.26490 of 2015* titled as *Sunita Sharma and others v. State of Punjab and others*, which was disposed of by this Court vide order dated 10.03.2017 with a direction to the respondents to consider their case for regularization. Pursuant to direction of this Court, Jitendra Sharma, I.F.S., Principal Chief Conservator of Forests, Punjab has passed order dated 31.07.2019 whereby petitioners have been regularized. The case of present petitioner is squarely covered by aforesaid order.

3. The State counsel vide order dated 08.08.2022 was directed to get instructions in this regard.
4. Learned State counsel submits that competent authority would look into claim of the petitioner and pass an appropriate order while considering order dated 10.03.2017 passed by this Court in the case of *Sunita Sharma (supra)* as well as order dated 31.07.2019 passed by Jitendra Sharma, I.F.S., Principal Chief Conservator of Forests, Punjab.
5. In the wake of statement of both sides, the present petition stands disposed of with a direction to the respondents to pass an appropriate order within three months from today.
