1. The present order shall dispose of both the petitions by a common order.
2. The present cross petitions have been filed against the impugned order dated 06.05.2019 passed by Court of Additional District and Sessions Judge, Principal Judge, Family Court, Panipat, whereby the interim maintenance application of the wife has been allowed but the maintenance granted is on lower side; and husband is aggrieved that the excessive interim

maintenance has been granted.

3. Learned counsel for the parties are *ad idem* that the petitions have been rendered infructuous as the main matter has been finally decided by the Family Court, Panipat vide judgment dated 01.09.2023, copy of which has been handed over in the Court and the same is taken on record.
