1. This is a contempt petition filed under Section 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, read with Article 215 of the Constitution of India, for punishing the respondent for disobeying the order dated 02.03.2022 passed in CWP-8830-2021.
2. Counsel for the respondent submits that the order dated 02.03.2022 passed in CWP-8830-2021 has since been complied with and speaking order dated 12.04.2024 has been passed. Copy of the order dated 12.04.2024 produced by the counsel for the respondent in the Court today, is taken on record. Registry is directed to scan and tag it at an appropriate place.
3. Counsel for the petitioner has not even disputed the aforesaid fact.
4. In view of the above, the present petition is rendered infructuous and dismissed, as such.
5. However, the petitioner would be at liberty to avail any other alternate remedy, but in accordance with law, if he feels aggrieved of the order passed by the respondent/concerned authority.
