In the present petition, petitioner is claiming benefit of compassionate appointment after the death of his father namely, Mejar Singh @ Major Singh, who was killed by the terrorist on 28.07.2003, keeping in view the circulars issued by the respondent-State of Punjab, copy which have been appended with the present petition as Annexures P/8 to P/13.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has already raised the said grievance before the respondents by way of submitting the representations dated 05.10.2016 & 02.06.2017 (Annexures P/6 and P/7 respectively), which are still pending consideration and the petitioner will be satisfied, at this stage, in case, a time bound direction is issued to the respondents to decide the said representations.

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Notice of motion.

Mr. T.P.S Chawla, Senior DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State and submits that in case, representations dated 05.10.2016 & 02.06.2017 (Annexures P/6 and P/7 respectively) have been received from the petitioner, the same will be decided in accordance with law and an appropriate speaking order will be passed within a period of 08 weeks from the date of receipt of copy of this order and in case, it is found feasible to grant the relief to the petitioner, the same will be extended to him otherwise, due reasons for not accepting the claim of the petitioner will be mentioned in the speaking order so passed, which will be conveyed to the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement made by learned counsel for the respondents, present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.
