1. Prayer in the instant civil writ petition filed under Articles 226/227 of Constitution of India is for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus, seeking directions to respondents to carve out the tatima in the revenue record regarding the release land of the petitioner, in pursuance of letter dated 29.08.2014 (Annexure P-4).
2. After arguing for some time, learned counsel for petitioner prays for withdrawal of this petition with liberty to pursue remedy, as available to the petitioner, before the revenue department.
