The petitioners have filed the present petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. with a prayer to grant anticipatory bail to them in case FIR No.142 dated 15.07.2023, registered under Sections 324, 336, 148, 149 of IPC and Section 27 of Arms Act, 1959 (offence under Section 326 IPC was added later on), at Police Station Dharmkot, Moga.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that in compliance of the order dated 18.08.2023 passed by a Co-ordinate Bench of this Court, the petitioners have joined the investigation.
3. Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Jaswinder Singh, has submitted that the petitioners have joined the investigation and are no longer required for further investigation.
4. In view of the statement made by learned counsel for the parties, the present petition is allowed and the interim order dated 18.08.2023, passed by a Co-ordinate Bench of this Court is made absolute. The petitioner shall continue to join investigation, as and when called by the Investigating Officer and shall also abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
5. Pending application, if any, is also disposed of.
