Prayer in this writ petition filed by the petitioner under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, is for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari, quashing the report dated 15.09.2022 (Annexure P-2) whereby checking staff of the respondents held that the petitioner was in a drunken condition while driving and held him responsible for damaging the bus and the order dated 19.09.2022 (Annexure P-3) whereby the petitioner has been suspended without affording an opportunity of personal hearing.

Perusal of the vernacular of document (Annexure P-3) shows that the petitioner has not been placed under suspension but has been relieved from service on account of driving the bus after drinking and damaging the bus.

The present petition has been filed by the petitioner by misstating the facts.



At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner wishes to the withdraw the present petition with liberty to file fresh one on the same cause of action with better particulars.

Prayer is accepted subject to payment of costs of Rs.5,000/- to be deposited by the petitioner with the Punjab & Haryana High Court Bar Clerk’s Association, within a period of one month.

Dismissed as withdrawn with aforesaid liberty.
