1. This writ petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of writ in the nature of *mandamus* directing the respondents to grant benefit of one increment on notional basis which becomes due on 1st July of the retirement year of the petitioner with all consequential benefits and to revise the pay and pension and grant all pensionary benefits along with 18% interest to the petitioner.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that for claiming retiral dues, petitioner has already submitted representations (Annexures P-4 and P-5) and he may be given liberty to supplement the said representations by filing a fresh representation within a period of two weeks and the same may be considered and decided by respondent No.4 in a time-bound manner.

4. Mr. Saurabh Mohunta, DAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of respondents.
5. I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner and have gone through the record of the case.
6. Without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case or the claim being made by the petitioner in the present petition, respondent No.4 is directed to consider and decide the claim made in the representations dated 08.01.2024 and 20.05.2024 (Annexure P-4 and P-5) and supplementary representation, to be moved by the petitioner within two weeks, in accordance with law, by passing a speaking order within a period of three months from the date of receipt of said representation and if there is no legal impediment, release the necessary benefits to the petitioner within a period of one month thereafter.
7. The petition stands disposed of.
