[1]. Instant petition has been preferred under Section 482 Cr. PC seeking quashing of the FIR (Annexure P-1), and all other subsequent proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise deed dated *nil* (Annexure P-3). Details of the FIR are as under: -

[2]. With the intervention of respectables and elderly people of the society, the parties have arrived at a settlement vide compromise deed (Annexure P-3), which is duly signed by them. The matter was referred to the Court below for recording of statements of the parties and to report

with respect to genuineness of the compromise arrived at between the parties.

[3]. Learned Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Sultanpur Lodhi, vide report dated 03.11.2023 has apprised this Court that the compromise arrived at between the parties is genuine and without any pressure.

[4]. Respondents Nos. 2 to 10 are represented by their counsel and do not oppose the compromise.

[5]. In view of the aforesaid report of learned Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Sultanpur Lodhi, and in view of the decision of the Hon'ble Supreme Court in “Gian Singh Vs. State of Punjab and another”, 2012(4) RCR (Criminal) 543 and “Narinder Singh and Others Vs. State of Punjab and Another”, (2014) 6 SCC 466, this Court is of the opinion that no useful purpose will be served by keeping with the criminal proceedings pending, since respondents No. 2 to 10 have themselves compromised the dispute with the petitioners.

[6]. In the circumstances, the present petition is allowed. FIR No. 320 dated 29.12.2021, under Sections 307, 323, 506, 427, 148 and 149 IPC, registered at Police Station Sultanpur Lodhi, (Annexure P-1) and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, are hereby quashed on the basis of compromise deed (Annexure P-3) qua the present petitioners.
