also delay of three years in lodging of the FIR.*

*Mr. Sarabjit Singh Cheema, DAG, Punjab, accepts notice on
behalf of the respondent-State.*

Adjourned to 19.12.2023.

*In the meantime, the petitioner is directed to join the
investigation and to co-operate fully with the investigation process
and on her doing so, the petitioner be released on interim bail,
subject to her furnishing personal bonds and surety to the satisfaction
of the Arresting/Investigating Officer. However, the petitioner shall
continue to join the investigation as and when called upon to do so
and shall abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438(2)
Cr.P.C.*

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in pursuance of the order dated 22.08.2023, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Kabal Singh, submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and she is not required for any further custodial interrogation.

In view of the statement made by learned State counsel, the interim order dated 22.08.2023, is hereby made absolute.
