**ARUN PALLI, J. (Oral):**

Learned counsel for the respondents submits that during the pendency of this petition, the claim of the petitioner for allotment of a tenement under the Licensing of Tenement and Sites and Services in Chandigarh Scheme, 1979, was examined and vide order dated 05.03.2024, he has been found ineligible per clause 7(iv) of the said scheme. Accordingly, his representation has since been rejected. It is urged that the petitioner, if aggrieved, would have to assail the said order in independent proceedings.

Faced with this, learned counsel for the petitioner submits, for, the petition is rendered infructuous, the same be disposed of as such. And, the petitioner, if so advised, would assail the order dated 05.03.2024 in appropriate proceedings.
