Present writ petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing of the impugned order dated 07.12.2017 (Annexure P-7) passed by the Appellate Tribunal whereby appeal of the petitioner was dismissed and the order dated 27.09.2017 (Annexure P-5) passed by the Tribunal under the Maintenance and Welfare of Parents & Senior Citizens Act, 2007 was upheld.
