In the present petition, the petitioner is claiming that he has secured 130 marks in the written examination in the ESM General Category, whereas person with 62 marks has been called for interview for the post of Station Supervisor.

By noticing the said fact, an interim order was passed so as to direct the respondents that the petitioner be interviewed provisionally and his result be kept in a sealed cover.

In order to find out whether the present petition survives or not, the provisional result was directed to be produced in Court today. The same has been produced.

Learned State counsel submits that the petitioner has secured 130 marks in the written examination and 10 marks in the viva-voice and

his total aggregate comes to 140 marks whereas the last candidate selected in the category in which the petitioner is competing has secured 151 marks, hence the petitioner could not make to the list of selected candidates.

No one has appeared on behalf of the petitioner to press the present petition.

Dismissed for non-prosecution.
