1. By way of present petition filed under Section 2-B read with Section 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, prayer has been made for initiating contempt proceedings against the respondents for willful non-compliance of the Order dated 09.05.2024 passed by this Court in CWP-10385-2020.

2. Learned State counsel has placed on record the recommendation letter in favour of petitioner for appointment to the post of Group-D (Peon) under SC category and further assures that the appointment letter shall be issued and the joining shall be carried out within a period of two weeks.

3. In view of the aforesaid undertaking, learned counsel for the petitioner does not press the present petition at this stage and submits that the same be disposed of with liberty to revive the same in case needful is not done.

4. Ordered accordingly.

5. However, in case the needful is not done within the

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aforementioned period, as per the undertaking, the petitioner would be at liberty to seek revival of the contempt petition and in that eventuality, the respondent would be liable to pay additional sum of Rs.50,000/- as costs from his own pocket in favour of the petitioner towards litigation expenses, immediately, i.e. on the first date of listing of revival application.

6. Rule stands discharged.
