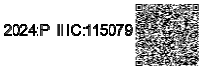

NAMIT KUMAR, J. (ORAL)

1. This writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of writ of *mandamus*, directing the respondents to consider the claim of the petitioners regarding regularization/regular appointment of their services in a time-bound manner in view of the policy dated 18.03.2011 (Annexure P-38) and order dated 29.02.2024 (Annexure P-52) passed by this Court in CWP-21281 of 2015 and connected cases. Further alternative prayer has been made for directing the respondents to grant the benefits of policy dated 16.05.2023 (Annexure P-45) adopted by the respondent-Corporation vide order dated 07.07.2023 to the petitioners.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners while referring to the averments made in paras 9 and 11 of the writ petition submits that the petitioners have submitted their applications for regularization in accordance with policies dated 18.03.2011 (Annexure P-38),



16.05.2023 (Annexure P-45) and office order dated 07.07.2023 to their respective officers along with requisite documents, however, no response has been received by the petitioners.

- 3. Notice of motion.
- 4. Mr. Gagneshwar Walia, Advocate, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 4 and Mr. Rajesh Sehgal, Addl. A.G., Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondent No.5.
- 5. Learned counsel for respondents No.1 to 4 submits that if the petitioners make a representation to this effect, their claim for regularization under the said policies shall be considered and finalised.
- 6. In view of the above, without commenting on the merits of the case, present petition is disposed of observing that if any such representation(s), detailing their applications, which have already been submitted by the petitioners for claiming regularization, are submitted by the petitioners within a period of one month from today, same shall be considered and disposed of by the respondents within a period of four months thereafter.
