1. Present writ petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing the complaint dated 22.09.2016 (Annexure P-5) filed by respondent No.3 and order dated 14.12.2016 (Annexure P-7) passed by respondent No.2 whereby the petitioner has been directed to handover the possession of the house in question.
2. None had appeared on behalf of the petitioner on 02.05.2023. Today also, nobody has appeared on behalf of the petitioner although the matter has been called twice.
3. Dismissed for non-prosecution.
4. Liberty is granted to the petitioner to move an application for restoration of the present petition or to file a fresh petition in case any cause survives.
