1. This petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.65, dated 12.03.2024, under Sections 307, 506, 148, 149 of IPC and Section 25 of Arms Act, registered at Police Station Mattaur, District S.A.S. Nagar (Mohali).

2. Vide order dated 13.08.2024, this Court had granted interim bail to the petitioner and directed him to join investigation.

3. Pursuant to order dated 13.08.2024, status report by way of affidavit dated 13.11.2024 of Talwinder Singh Gill, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police (Detective), District SAS Nagar on behalf of respondent-State, has been filed in Court today, which is taken on record.

3.1 Learned State counsel, on instructions, submits that in compliance of order dated 13.08.2024, petitioner has joined investigation on 05.09.2024 and he is not required for any custodial interrogation.

4. I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

5. In view of the fact that the petitioner has joined investigation and his custodial interrogation is not required, the order dated 13.08.2024 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute. The petitioner shall abide by the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. in letter and spirit.

6. Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
