Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that though the petitioners were working with the respondents on the post of Inclusive Education Resource Teacher (I.E.R.T.) under the Sarva Shiksha Abhiyan Scheme but they have not been paid salary from 01.04.2015 till 31.12.2015, which should be released by the respondents along with interest.

Learned counsel for the petitioners further submits that the petitioners have already raised the said grievance in the representation dated 13.03.2024 (Annexure P-6), which is still pending consideration with the respondents and the petitioners will be satisfied, at this stage, in case direction is issued to the respondents to decide the same by passing an appropriate speaking order in a time bound manner.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Arun Gupta, DAG, Punjab, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State and

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Mr. Anil Chawla, Advocate accepts notice on behalf of respondent No.3

Learned counsel for the respondents submits that in case, representation dated 13.03.2024 (Annexure P-6) has been received in the office of the concerned authorities and the same is still pending consideration with the authorities concerned, the same will be decided by the competent authority within a period of eight weeks from the date of the receipt of certified copy of this order by passing an appropriate speaking order and in case, it is found feasible to accept the claim of the petitioners, the same will be extended to them, otherwise due reasons for not accepting the claim of the petitioners will be mentioned in the speaking order so passed, which will be conveyed to the petitioners.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that keeping in view the statement of the learned counsel for the respondents, the present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.
